

## 2024 Offices On the Ballot

Filing Deadline for all candidates is **December 20, 2023**

**Primary Election – March 19, 2024** *(subject to change by OH Legislature)*

**General Election – November 5, 2024**

The 2024 Elections will include the following **Partisan\* Offices**. The 2024 Primary Election will only include **Partisan\* Offices** if there are contested races with the Party:

### FEDERAL:

- President
- US Senator
- US House of Representatives - 7<sup>th</sup> District

### STATE:

- Ohio Senate – 22<sup>nd</sup> District
- Ohio House of Representatives – 66<sup>th</sup> & 67<sup>h</sup> Districts
- Ohio Supreme Court Justice (3 positions)
- Court of Appeals – 9<sup>th</sup> District (1 position)

### COUNTY:

- Medina County Commissioner (2 positions)
- Medina County Sheriff
- Medina County Recorder
- Medina County Treasurer
- Medina County Engineer
- Medina County Prosecutor
- Medina County Clerk of Courts
- Medina County Coroner
- Medina County Domestic Relations Judge\*\*
- Central Committee (121 positions - 1 per precinct)

\*Definition of Partisan vs. Non-Partisan

**Partisan** means the candidate runs for office as a member of a Party, and therefore, the Party will be listed on the ballot by the candidate's name.

**Non-partisan** means the candidate does not declare a Party when they run for the office. Only the candidate's name appears on the ballot. No Party is listed.

\*\*Medina County Domestic Relations Judge is the only office that will appear on the November ballot as non-partisan following a partisan Primary election.
